Please indicate "*Ergänzungsstudium*" when applying.
- Your study level when studying abroad in the exchange programs will be bachelor's level.
- Please enquire with your department about special requirements regarding recognition of courses, rules of the LJPA etc.
- If you plan to sit the "zivilrechtliche Klausuren" of the state exam in September, this may cause problems with the semester start at the host university when you go abroad – please check before you apply.
